Don't hold your breath. The point is that since the last call to LOADCT, the colour table may have been further changed by calls to TVLCT. So the *number* of the last-loaded colour table is not necessarily meaningful, while the RGB *values* that make up the current colour table (as returned by TVLCT, /GET) is.
