I wrote earlier:

- > IF your object methods are all in the same file...
- > THEN you can use the CLASS keyword to RESOLVE_ALL
- > to list your object classes and they will be
- > resolved along with everything else.

I'm told now, by someone who should know, that the methods don't all have to be in the same file. Each method can be in its own file, if it is named appropriately, etc. The important thing is that the class name be present (as it would have to be if you named the thing correctly):

```
myclass__define.pro  
myclass__init.pro  
myclass__magic.pro
```

```
RESOLVE_ALL, ... , CLASS='myclass'
```
