Hi Sheldon, :-)

without the possibility to easily check, but the `loc_id` in the call to `H5A_OPEN` should be "An integer representing the identifier of the group, dataset, or named datatype containing the attribute within." So there must at least be one call `H5D_OPEN` before it to receive a valid ID of an object which can contain attributes. In your example, `loc_id` is the file ID, and the file itself seems not to carry any attributes. BTW, are you sure that `satellite_id` is in fact an attribute and not a dataset? Have you just tried the good old `READ_HDF` routine?
