Kenneth Bowman wrote:

- > Neither file will open in any of the software tools I normally use with PS files
- > (Illustrator, Distiller, pstopdf, Photoshop (reports a parser error),
- > GraphicConverter, ...)

If the Adobe utilities cannot handle this file, I think you are on a dead end. Unfortunately, postscript errors are really obnoxious, and totally unintelligible even to experts.

Have you tried ghostscript? Sometimes pstops will clean a file enough to get the rest of ghostscript (or other utilities) to understand the file. Another one is to try ps2epsi, as it may filter out some of the offending commands.

Are you sure the file is ascii only? Some utilities save to a "binary" form, that is perfectly fine with printers, but utterly useless with other tools.
