Thanks Peter,

Around midnight last night I solved the problem as you suggested (`my_array = my_array[*, good_indices]`). I didn't think about the asterisk *, i.e. cutting all dimensions with the one dimension array: `good_indices`. I used the the `MAKE_ARRAY` because I had to sort my data by individual satellites (NOAA15, NOAA16 and so forth). It was easier to do this with the file strings and hence `make_array([3,344], /string)`. It may not be pretty but it works :).

Now I am tackling calling a python program from IDL.
