Around midnight last night I solved the problem as you suggested (my\_array = my\_array[\*, good\_indices]). I didn't think about the asterisk \*, i.e. cutting all dimensions with the one dimension array: good\_indices. I used the the MAKE\_ARRAY because I had to sort my data by individual satellites (NOAA15, NOAA16 and so forth). It was easier to do this with the file strings and hence make\_array([3,344], /string). It may not be pretty but it works:).

Now I am tackling calling a python program from IDL.
