Maybe you want something like FSC_BASE_FILENAME, which
can parse a filename into the base name, the directory,
and its file extension:

```
IDL> file = 'some_ordinaryfile.h5'  
IDL> name = FSC_Base_Filename(file, Directory=d, Extension=e)  
IDL> Print, e  
      h5  
IDL> file = 'some_ordinaryfile.hdf'  
IDL> name = FSC_Base_Filename(file, Directory=d, Extension=e)  
IDL> Print, e  
      hdf
```
