Hello everyone,

I'm having a problem that has to do with opening up different instances of iTools. In my iTool, I create some UI panels, and as is required, I use ITREGISTER to register them with the iTools system. I create my iTool from a procedure, then I go about my business. However, if someone wanted to close my iTool, go back to the command line, then open up ilmage (or some other iTool), they would still have all my panels in their new iTool.

I need some help in figuring out a way so that after my iTool is created, I delete the panels from the iTools registry so any new instances of iTools don't have my panels in them.

I hope that there is some way to handle this problem, because no matter what functionality I can actually implement into my iTool, if I can't leave the iTools system as it should be, my stuff probably won't get used at all.
