Of the options listed there I'd recommend the 2nd. - disable SELinux.

Until SELinux matures, and RedHat/Fedora manage to make it work reliably (and not break the system every time they release a new update) your system is much more likely to work with it disabled. Unless you are operating network servers (http, smtp, ftp etc.) the chances of it making the slightest difference to the security of your system are about zero.

Alternatively you can switch to permissive mode, in which SELinux doesn't enforce the rules, simply logs violations to the system log, so you can fix the mistakes yourself... ;-)
