Hey David, I know you already found the library, but there's a handy little tool on Fedora/Redhat systems (and others based on rpm packages) called yum. Once it's set up, you can do fun stuff like "yum provides libXp" and you'll get back a list of all the packages that have some file or feature matching the name "libXp". It's just really handy when you're trying to figure out what package provides a certain file.
