Ok, my preferred solution would actually be to running idl locally (as opposed to ssh to a server) in Linux, editing in kwrite, at full resolution of my laptop, but since I don't feel like wrestling with the Sisyphean task of achieving all that while trying to get something done, I ordered the Windows version of IDL. I'm using idlde because I can't get idl to compile the pro files in my current working directory -- it compiles the library routines I call but won't compile my files when called. idlde allows me to load them all at once and compile them all at once, but I still need line numbers because ctrl+g is cumbersome to be constantly hitting about every minute. So, is there a way to get idlde to show line numbers of the currently displayed file?
