In our office, we have tried Debian, RedHat/Fedora and Suse, and for most application, the Suse package was found to work best. It may be important to make sure you install something else than (a) a preset config ('workstation', 'graphical software', or what they are all called) or (b) a minimum config. Some of these 'lib missing' problems simply disappeared when we'd install a full set of everything contained in a Linux package (what's using up a bit of harddisk against using up all of my time trying to find a certain little library file?). By and large, we had less problems with missing files on Suse than on other Linuxes - at least as far as IDL and The Gimp are concerned... Wolf.
