Since you already seem to know (La)TeX, you may be able to use psfrag to postprocess the eps output from IDL, using the full (La)TeX for the labels. The psfrag is probably installed on your system (if you have TeX installed, that is). Try `texdoc pfgguide' on the (Linux) command line to get the manual and see if it may work for you. It is part of both teTeX and MikTeX.
