- > the x-axis separately. It is just the y-axis title that I want to
- > change. I want it to be centered between the two plots so it does not
- > get duplicated twice. Does anyone have any ideas?

Although the best solution is almost certainly to directly specify POSITION keywords for the plots (with a /NOERASE for the second), then XYOUTS as David suggests, you might have a go at padding the ytitle of one of the plots with spaces. It's a rough and ready, clunky solution, but it might just work.
