Hi,

I am trying to plot 2 plots on one page vertically. Each has a different x-axis but they all have identical y-axis. Currently it looks like:

I have tried the MULTIPLOT program listed here but it requires that there be no labelling of the two x-axis... I need to be able to label the x-axis separately. It is just the y-axis title that I want to

change. I want it to be centered between the two plots so it does not get duplicated twice. Does anyone have any ideas?
