But, I want something like this

```
minval = -30
maxval = +50
```

i.e my colorbar should look something like this

Basically, what I want is that the color for the data value 0 should be the same for all the output images. That is, if I use a Blue-Red color table, then the 0 data value should always be green. The main problem is because the minimum and maximum value keeps on changing for different arrays. If for the first array the min value is -30 and max is 50, for the second array it might be -50 and +75, and so on.
