> Is there a way to "pad" the distance between plots in !p.multi? I have  
> an issue with the right hand side of one of my graph's y-axis (which  
> has an axis label) running into the left hand side of the adjacent  
> plots left hand side y-axis label. I tried using the position keyword  
> in plot; however since I'm plotting within a loop it overlaid all the  
> plots on one another overriding the !p.multi command. Any suggestions?

Look into !X.MARGIN or !Y.MARGIN for system-wide stuff, or just set the XMARGIN or YMARGIN  
keywords to PLOT.
