I don't have any experience with the Freudenreich LOESS code, but I won't let that stop me from commenting!

Do you know if the Freudenreich LOESS code is based on the netlib loess code? I did not know there was such a beast implemented in IDL. Something I've been thinking about trying for some time is making an IDL wrapper for locfit (<http://www.locfit.info/>), which I use from R. It is mostly written in C, so it would not be impossible to use it by making library calls from IDL.
