I have a short program that can be used to batch process files.

```
-----  
function file_rep, filelist, func  
  
openr, file_lun, filelist,/get_lun  
filename=""  
while NOT EOF(file_lun) do begin  
  readf,file_lun,filename  
  a=call_function(func,filename)  
endwhile  
free_lun, file_lun  
end  
-----
```

To use this, first create a file containing the list of files you would like converted. You will also need to write a function that takes a single file name as it's argument and does the processing you want on a single file. So, you would use this function something like this:

```
IDL> dummy=file_rep('filelist','ascii2envi')
```

You will need to write the ascii2envi.pro function.
