Not sure if you're still working on this, but if not maybe it will help the "next guy."

REVERSIBLE_OPERATION is not doing what you think it's doing. Undo/redo is automatic (one way or another) for all IDLitDataOperation operations. If REVERSIBLE_OPERATION=1, then previous data will not be cached because undo'ing will call the undoExecute method of the operation to be called. If REVERSIBLE_OPERATION=0 then previous data will be cached because that is the only way to provide undo.

But I'm not sure if this is what's causing your speed problem. The itools haven't exactly been speedy for me. Though there were some performance enhancements that affect iimage in IDL 6.2, I'm not sure they would help either.
