I was wondering if there was a more efficient way to populate an array created using the MAKE\_ARRAY function. This is how I am populating the array right now -

```
data = BYTARR(202000L)
; populate byte array with valid data from some input source
array = MAKE_ARRAY(1000,101, Type = 2)
offset = 0L
FOR k = 0L, 100999L DO BEGIN
  array(k) = FIX(data, offset)
  offset = offset + 2
ENDFOR
```

Is there a way I can populate 'array' without using a loop to populate each element, and instead do a array = FIX(data)??
