> undefined variable is invoked, the error returns the name of the  
> variable. If a `$v` is defined, then `Expr($v)` should be defined also,  
> except in specific cases that have their own errors (e.g. non-existent  
> structure tags, pointer stuff).

I agree.

It has been years since I have seen a similar error message, but the last time it happened it was due to a bug in IDL that was fixed in the subsequent release.

What IDL version are you using?

I suggest finding the simplest code that reproduces the message, and then filing a bug report with RSI.
