The error is due to the fact that "123 means the _octal_ value of 123. How somebody could get this idea is beyond me. Even stranger than a leading zero, IMHO. To make it even more interesting, IDL does not check for unbalanced quotes, so the following works:

%print, '123 123 %print, "123 83

Lovely, isn't it?
