Looks to me like you have an array of integers which you accidentally read into a byte array, and now you'd like to put things back in order. The best way would be to read the data into an intarr of the right dimensions in the first place. If it's too late, write out your byte array to a file:

```
openw,1,filename  
writeu,1,data  
close,1
```

and read it back how you want it:

```
array = MAKE_ARRAY(1000,101, Type = 2)  
openr,1,filename  
readu,1,array  
close,1
```

You may need to use `swap_endian` if it comes out byte-swapped.
