It only works with the stanza in .emacs that I provided. The next release won't need this, but for now, you must set the "comment-add" parameter.

- > While we are on the subject, is there a way to associate a key sequence
- > in xemacs to inserting a set string, say ";{{{" ***with the
- > appropriate indentation***?

Yes, indeed. You might add something like this to your idlwave-mode-hook inside of .emacs:

```
(define-key (current-local-map)
[f6]
'(lambda () (interactive)
    (insert ";{{{")}
    (indent-according-to-mode)))
```

The same pattern can be used to insert anything.
