you do not need a complete IDE, just a command line interface.

1. create runcmd.pro

```
pro runcmd
cmd=""
while 1 do begin
    read, cmd, prompt='IDL> '
    x=execute(cmd)
endwhile
end
```

```
runcmd
end
```

2. compile it and save, file='runcmd.sav', /routines

3. run idl -vm with runcmd.sav, and you would have a command prompt if EXECUTE would be operational. (This would work on linux/unix. On windows, you could create an editable text widget with EXECUTE in the event handling routine.)
