- > I am wondering what is wrong here, why I need two contour lines
- > commands to get the contoure lines come up?

You can't both establish the contour data space AND overplot the contour lines (OVERPLOT keyword) on the same command. OVERPLOT assumes a data space is already established. (It is similar to PLOTS in this regard.)

I would use a CONTOUR with NODATA and [XY]STYLE=5 keywords to establish the data coordinate space. Then use the CONTOUR command with OVERPLOT to draw the contour lines, if that is what you want to do.

IMGDISP or TVIMAGE will make this a WHOLE lot easier for you! :-)
