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Look up the section in the IDL 6.3 documentation dealing with Connector Objects for Java and COM. Try it out and see if it will be able to meet your needs. If you're only doing "number crunching" with IDL, the Connector Object should suffice. The Export Bridge Assistant Module should only be necessary if you must have a complex relationship between IDL objects and Java/COM objects.
