I am using idl licensed to my school (Fefora Linux system, IDL 6.2). Recently I have changed my default shell from tcsh to bash, then I found some standard IDL routines are no longer working. For example, the procedure Identity.pro in

/opt/rsi/idl/lib/identity.pro

is not recognized by the idl program. Although when I expand '<IDL_DEFAULT>' variable, I can still see the directory

/opt/rsi/idl/lib/

is there. The same problem applies to procedures that read netCDF files.

This is quite confusing to me. Could any of you help me or give some suggestions?
