Ideally, we should be able to specify a compiler directive at the top of a .pro file to indicate that RESOLVE_ROUTINE should compile the specified dependency.

In practice, I tend to arrange my code into modules which live in separate directories. I tend to compile directories rather than individual files. For example, you might have a few different algorithms which are invoked by CALL_FUNCTION. I'd recommend keeping those in a module (subdirectory).

My trick for IDL library routines is to use UNIX soft links. I just create a directory which contains soft links to the IDL library routines of interest. I used to have a IDLgrObjects module directory for all graphics atoms, but I think that iTools resolve all takes care of that now.
