Sorry, that URL is not quite as helpful as I thought. But the way I read message 23 in the thread is that the IDL IDLBridge object is supported in the VM, but its Execute method is not. This was written by "CP", a pseudonymous source who sounds pretty authoritative (and has a very cool email address).

Hmm ... this implies the IDL IDLbridge is pretty much useless in the VM. You can create a bridge but you can't make it actually execute IDL code. Perhaps someone more knowledgeable than me can confirm?
