Do you want a screenshot of your widget program? I'm don't think you can do that from within IDL, but any decent image viewer / editor (e.g., Irfan View on Windows) can take screenshots. If you can find a command line tool (probably Image Magick has one) to capture the currently active window, you can just spawn a call to that.

If you don't care about the exact widget layout but more about the information in the widgets, you can just capture the draw widget with TVREAD, print it and manually print the values from the text / label widgets next to it (XYOUTS).
