You can

```
IDL> print, t, format='(3f10.2,$)' & print ;$ means no carriage return.
```

Or simply

```
IDL> print, t.a, t.b, t.c
```

If you don't know the number of tags, use N_TAGS(t) to find it and use the STRING procedure in an iterative loop:

```
IDL> text = "  
IDL> for i=0,n_tags(t)-1 do text = text+string(t.(i))  
IDL> print,text  
0.00000    0.00000    0.00000
```
