I'd be surprised if you can do it without programming, but it shouldn't be hard. Split the path using `strsplit()` and `path_sep()`, count how many first elements are the same, add a chain of `'..'+path_sep()` to equal the remaining elements in your from-path, and tack on the remaining elements of the to-path.
