We use `read_gdf()` to read it. If you have `read_gdf()` already, then it's `variableToContainData=read_gdf(filename)`, where `filename` is a string containing the filename with the extension `.gdf`. I also posted a comma delimited version of the same data. Take that into Excel (it should open as an Excel document), then Save As and you can export it as any Excel data type.
