I have an array 'A' with two columns, latitudes and longitudes, and several lines. A need to make another array with the elements of A that don't repeat. An example:

A[0]=[20.4, 40.3, 50.2, 50.2] A[1]=[30.2, 60.2, 32.4, 32.4]

Note that the third and fourth pairs are the same (50.2, 32.4). So, I need to make another array and remove one of the pairs. So, I would have:

A[0]=[20.4, 40.3, 50.2] A[1]=[30.2, 60.2, 32.4]
