Hi there (sorry for the cross-posting),

I have some eps plot (done with IDL, some of them in colours) that are far too big.

I should upload them on online archive server and I have to resize them. I have tried something like the following command (I'm using linux)

gs -r300 -dEPSCrop -dTextAlphaBits=4 -sDEVICE=png16m -sOutputFile=fig.png -dBATCH -dNOPAUSE fig.eps

but it does not work.

I was wondering if there's any tip or trick to reduce the size of the eps file to be used in a latex file.

I have opened the eps file with text editor and canceled the %% lines.

That reduce the size of almost nothing:(

Apparently IDL is clever and there aren't any redundant fonts ...

I would also be interested in know if there's any command to give IDL in order to produce file with lower dimension (maybe a good compromise between quality and size...)
