> or DXF file) on a TV? I have a satellite image being showed on TV and I
> would like to overlay it with this vector.

Overlays are typically placed on images with the PLOTS
command. The only trick (if there is one) is to get
the proper data coordinate space set up. Typically,
with satellite images, this is done with some kind of
MAP_SET command, or something very like it.
