When using GRIDDATA, you might try setting the SECTORS keyword to a higher value, like 3 or 4. (You may also need to set EMPTY_SECTORS=0, I'm not sure of the default.) This should force the procedure to interpolate only the points that are "well-surrounded" by data, and hopefully provide a better interpolant. Everything else will be set to the value of MISSING.
