David Fanning writes:

> I have modified the idljavabrc configuration file in IDL
> in the following way:
>
> JVM Classpath =
> $CLASSPATH;C:\RS\IDL62\external\objbridge\java\jbexamples.jar
> JVM Classpath =
> $CLASSPATH;C:\RS\IDL62\external\objbridge\java\TryGeometry.jar
```

I've noticed in my log file that this doesn't set put my TryGeometry.jar file on the JVM path, so I have modified the configuration file to this:

```
JVM Classpath = $CLASSPATH;C:\RS\IDL62\external\objbridge\java
\jbexamples.jar;C:\RS\IDL62\external\objbridge\java\TryGeometry.jar
```

This sets my JVM Classpath to have the right jar files, but I get the same result when I try to create the object. :-(
