- > So, I agree I need to examine the contents of this file.
- > But I don't know how to access the "command line" where
- > these commands are to be run. I've tried the Windows
- > command line, but these commands are not recognized
- > as valid commands.

OK, I added the JDK to my PATH and the commands now work from the command window. When I examine the contents of my TryGeometry jar file, I get this:

```
tryGeometry/  
tryGeometry/Line.class  
tryGeometry/Main.class  
tryGeometry/Point.class
```

I don't know WHY the tryGeometry here starts with a lowercase t instead of the UPPERCASE T I've used every other damn place, but that apparently is the problem! Now I can successfully create my object in IDL!

```
IDL> obj = obj_new("IDLJAVAOBJECT$TRYGEOMETRY_POINT", $  
"tryGeometry.Point", 0.25, 0.25)
```

Sigh... What a lot of work. Thanks, everyone, for your help. Now, on to the next BIG thing... :-)
