You can read *thousands* of files in the same procedure in IDL. Just be sure you close each logical unit number (with `FREE_LUN`, if you obtained the LUN with `GET_LUN`, or with `CLOSE` if you just chose a LUN from the pool 1-99) before you open the next file. This way you won't run out of logical unit numbers.
