You can read *thousands* of files in the same procedure in IDL. Just be sure you close each logical unit number (with FREE_LUN, if you obtained the LUN with GET_LUN, or with CLOSE if you just chose a LUN from the pool 1-99) before you open the next file. This way you won't run out of logical unit numbers.
