- > not from idltool.

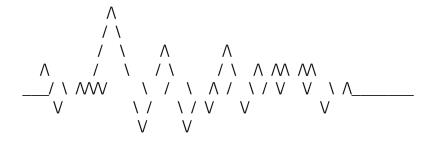

- > because you used the help facility at sometime during the session (it
- > still crashes even if you quit from help first)

IDL 4.0 would produce segmentation faults on our HP's in a variety of situations. Since loading 4.0.1, I haven't crashed yet. It's one of the know bugs fixed in 4.0.1 for HP.
