WIDGET\_CONTROL is not a guaranteed way of changing the size of a widget. Under X it sends a resize event and the widget attempts to change its size. This is only a \*request\* to the X window manager - the window manager does not have to honour it. If you try it using IRIX 5.2 and IDL 4.0 you will find that it doesn't work - what it does is to resize the vertical size to 0.

The method I use is to destroy the old draw widget and create a new one of the correct size.
