RESOLVE_ROUTINE unless I use EXECUTE and IDL_IDLBRIDGE instead? How
come !QUIET or CATCH, ERROR won't take of it?

Or is there another way than using execute so that any errors caused by
RESOLVE_ROUTINE (including syntax errors) won't be shown / printed to
screen?

PRO LOAD_ROUTINE, ROUTINE
  !QUIET=1
  CATCH, ERROR
  IF (ERROR NE 0) THEN RETURN
  RESOLVE_ROUTINE, ROUTINE, /EITHER
END
```

```
PRO MY_PROCEDURE

  LOAD_ROUTINE, ROUTINE
...
END
```
