> bar = BYTSCl(bar, TOP=(ncolors-1 < (255-bottom))) + bottom
>
> Any insights into that?

I guess it's fair to wonder why I care about this. One reason I care is that I think the line that causes confusion is the correct way to write the line, since it is less ambiguous than the second way. :-)
