> does not solve the problem. But I have to mention that the problem
> arises, when I create a triangle. When I use a rhomb it works fine

Well, I don't know. All the filled triangles in SYMCAT seem to work fine:

```
IDL> plot, findgen(11)
```

```
IDL> plots, 10, 3, psym=symcat(19), symsize=4
```

Do you suppose something is wrong with the way you calculate the triangle?
