Here is the code I used. Almost verbatim from the aforementioned Tech Tip:

tool = itGetCurrent(tool=oTool)
;get an object descriptor for the text annotation class:
oDesc = oTool->GetAnnotation('Text')
;initialize an object reference for a new text annotation:
oText = oDesc->GetObjectInstance()
;set the properties on the text annotation object:
oText->SetProperty, _STRING=title_text, _HORIZONTAL_ALIGN=1, \$
LOCATIONS=[6,330,0.99]
;add the text object to the annotation layer:

The LOCATIONS obviously are in your data coordinate system units.

oTool->Add, oText, LAYER='VISUALIZATION LAYER'
