There must be some good reason why the Annotation Layer is specified in Normalize coordinates and the rest of the Plot stuff is in Data coordinates, but it escapes me right now. In any case, having the Plot title in normalized coordinates causes the title to bounce around quite a bit as you resize the window. It starts out just right, then it gets far away again, now it jumps right into the plot!

Is there a way to put the title in the Visualization layer so I can specify its location in data coordinates?
